Show Rules

1. All exhibits to be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
2. By submission of an entry form the exhibitor agrees to comply with the Australian finch society rules.
3. All C.O.Y.B. entries must have been bred by the exhibitor in the relevant year, and need to be rung for awards.
4. All pairs entered of a species that is visually sex-able must consist of cock and hen.
5. Nominations are the responsibility of the exhibitor.
No Nomination, No Award.
6. Wrong entries will be re-classed before judging.
7. The judge's decision will be final.
8. Protests may be lodged in writing & secured with £10 deposit. This will be refunded if the protest is upheld by the A.F.S. show manager and committee.
9. Cages are to be handled or moved by A.F.S. Appointed officials only.
10. The A.F.S. will take every care of the exhibitor's property. But the entire risk and responsibility remains that of the exhibitor. No liability under any circumstances will be held by A.F.S. or its officials.
11. **All exhibits must comply with current state VETERINARY BIO SECURITY MEASURES. Printed on entry form.**
12. Birds to be benched by 9 AM.
13. Book in birds on Sunday morning 7-30 am to 9 am.
Check out birds from 4-00 pm.
14. All standard foreign show cages accepted.
15. Show class entry free.
16. **The A.F.S. Reserves the right to refuse entry to any exhibit.**
17. **Entries close 9pm 30th September 2018.**

Bio Security.

To comply with the terms of the **Licence** that our meetings, bird sales and exhibitions are held.

The following conditions must be complied with:-

All bird sales / exchanges must be recorded, this must include the name and address and phone number of both the seller and the buyer, also any identifying features or individual identification (rings) of the purchased birds(s).

No sales or exchanges of birds to take place in the car park.

All exhibitors / entrants must disinfect the show cages, crates or box before the event and be advised that they should be cleansed and disinfected on return to the home premises and before they are used to hold any other bird, Buyers must isolate the purchased bird(s) from all other birds (except those purchased at the same event) for at least one week.

Any signs of ill health observed in the purchased bird(s) during this period of isolation must be reported to a Veterinary surgeon and such birds must not be mixed with any other birds until the presence of an avian modifiable disease has been ruled out. All litter and manure within the cages, crates or boxes must be contained until disposal. Any spillages outside cages to be cleansed and disinfected immediately.

All litter and manure must be disposed of in a manner which does not present a risk of spread of the disease, e.g. in sealed bags for normal refuse collection in such a manner that other birds do not have direct access to it.

Newcastle Disease

Exhibitors must read and sign the Newcastle disease declaration and hand to the Biosecurity Officer on arrival outside the entrance.

FAILURE TO PRODUCE THIS DOCUMENT DULY SIGNED AND COMPLETED WILL RESULT IN YOUR BIRDS BEING PREVENTED FROM ENTERING THE PREMISES.
