Gold : For all AFS Branches, Specialist Foreign Bird shows, The National at Stafford and AFS Members show.

Open : For all Cage Bird Societies and Clubs.

The Open Patronage is now being offered **free** to all applying Cage Bird Societies and Clubs.

Applications must be made in writing to the Patronage Secretary using the application enclosed and must contain a large SAE. Conditions of the free rosettes are that the following advert (also downloadable from the AFS website) is placed in the Show Catalogue and results sent to the AFS following the show.
