DEFRA General Licence for Bird Gatherings – Notes for participants
Valid at 22nd June 2026

1.3 Biosecurity – Advice to participants (there is some duplication)

Please note:

- All birds should be health checked before traveling to the gathering and
- All birds travelling from the gathering to any premises (whether they are returning to premises of origin or to a new location) should be isolated from other birds at that premises and health monitored for at least one week afterwards.

Participants must:

- a. Comply with the mandatory registration requirements for keepers of birds kept at any premises in Great Britain; and
- b. for any bird attending a gathering in England, that they must be registered and must provide their CPH number before being granted entry
- c. where the premises of origin is in England or Wales the keeper must be registered with APHA on kept bird register
- d. where the premises of origin is in Scotland the keeper must be registered on the Scottish Kept Bird Register operated by APHA

No cage, crate, basket, receptacle or other container which is excessively contaminated with bird droppings or other material of bird origin will be allowed. 'Excessively contaminated' means contaminated with excessive material of bird origin, more than could be reasonably expected to be produced during transport of the birds to the gathering.

Birds are not permitted to enter the gathering unless the participant declares that they do not originate from premises or areas that are under restrictions related to confirmation of a notifiable avian disease, including from any temporary disease control zone imposed by Ministers and can provide a valid CPH number to verify this (if necessary) ; and

Birds on arrival are to be visually inspected by a named bird expert or veterinarian designated by the licensee; and

Any birds that fail the inspection or show any clinical signs of avian notifiable disease during the event, are to be reported immediately to APHA. Such birds must then be prevented from participating at the gathering and be kept isolated from other birds until they have been examined by a veterinary inspector and written authority obtained from APHA permitting them to leave the gathering.

Any cages, crates, baskets, pens or other containers are to be cleansed and disinfected as soon as reasonably practicable after the end of the gathering and in any case before they are used again.

Anyone seen to be visibly contaminated with faecal material, feathers or other material of bird origin is to be refused entry to the bird area until such contamination has been removed.

All participants check their birds for disease prior to departure from the gathering.

The declaration below must be signed before entry to the show.

Exhibitor Declaration

- a. I have read the information provided and I will comply with the biosecurity requirements; and
- b. To the best of my knowledge my birds have not been in contact with any notifiable avian disease agents and do not show any signs of infection; and
- c. The birds do not originate from a premises address within a Protection Zone, Surveillance Zone, Temporary Control Zone, Temporary Movement Control Zone or other notifiable avian disease controlled zone
- d. The premises of origin has been registered on the Kept Birds Register (for premises in England and Wales) or the Scottish Kept Birds Register (SKBR) for premises in Scotland, and I have supplied details of the CPH number.
