Please list all birds that you are bringing to the Show on this form, using one line for each bird / pair of birds before you enter the halls. When you sell a bird place the name, address and telephone number of the buyer or their name and PS membership number in the last column. If you buy birds during the Show add them at the bottom of the form. When you are ready to leave the Show this form must be brought to the PS Stand. During the Show and at the end of the Show we will be carrying out spot checks on tables to ensure that this important paperwork has been correctly completed. Failure to complete the paperwork will result in you not being allowed to show for two years. If friends share a table both members need to complete a form.

We are required to keep these forms for 3 months. Additional copies of this form are available from the P.S. stand at the show or from our office.

NO HAND REARED OR PET BIRDS CAN BE SOLD AT THIS SALE.

Only 2 birds per cage, trios of 3 finches are acceptable. All cages to be painted and clean.

If rules are broken you will not be able to show for two years. If there is not sufficient space on these forms please feel free to photocopy them.

Please note: Even if you are exempt from bird registration under the guidelines: If your birds are taken outdoors at any time, for example to be exercised, trained, or taken to bird gatherings or shows, they must be registered. It is an offence not to register your birds. This means that everyone bringing birds to the show must ensure they have completed the bird registration process with Defra, instructions for free registration can be found at <https://www.gov.uk/guidance/register-as-a-keeper-of-less-than-50-poultry-or-other-captive-birds>

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
